Course Goal

The goal of this course is to help participants develop the resuscitation skills and knowledge required to perform their professional roles.

Objectives

Successful Participants will be able to:

- ❑ Demonstrate CPR and BLS skills and the ability to integrate ALS skills into BLS framework
- ❑ Demonstrate the ability to assess and recognize the infant or child at risk of cardiopulmonary failure or arrest
- ❑ Demonstrate cognitive and psychomotor skills necessary for assessment, resuscitation, and stabilization of the infant or child in respiratory distress, respiratory failure, shock, cardiopulmonary failure or cardiopulmonary arrest

Educational Credit
